

RED PINE

A shade intolerant, long lived, moderate to fast growing native pine with 4" to 6" long, flexible, dark green needles. Attaining heights of 50' to 80' with a trunk 2' to 3' in diameter, it prefers well drained sandy to sandy loam soils. Red Pine is resistant to a variety of insects and diseases. Most often planted for timber production and screens but is also used as ornamental. The wood is generally used for construction, mill work, and pulpwood.
