

NORTHERN RED OAK

The fastest growing of our native hardwoods with sharply toothed, 7-11 lobed leaves, turning red in autumn. Attaining heights of 60' to 80' with a trunk 3' or more in diameter. Prefers welldrained clay to loam sand with full sunlight. Often planted for wildlife, aesthetics and timber production. The wood is generally used for furniture, millwork and veneer.
